

PSALM 92

*A song of praise on the day before the Sabbath:
for when the earth was first inhabited; by David,*

- 1 The Lord reigns, He is attired appropriately;
He is clothed as a Lord of power,
and He hath girded Himself well.**
For He hath firmly established the world,
that it may not be shaken.
- 2 Thy throne was established at that time,
for Thou art from eternity.**
- 3 The rivers have risen, O Lord,
the rivers have lifted up their voices;**
- 4 the rivers shall rise and will overflow
with the clamor of many waters.
Incredible is the surging of the sea,
but the Lord on high is astonishing!
- 5 a) Thy testimonies especially confirm this.
**b) Holiness becomes Thy house, O Lord,
for the total extent of time.**

Psalm 92 is of the 13th Kathisma. It accompanies Psalm 91 when it is read at the middle of the First Hour of Prayer. It is also read at the Ninth Royal Hour of Theophany and at the Saturday Great Vespers reminding us of Christ's royal enthronement. Verses 1, 3 and 5b) serve as the Prokeimenon on the Liturgy served at Saturdays. Verses 1, 2 and 5b) are the responses to the Second Antiphon on weekday liturgies

The Morning Gospel of the Orthros is No. Two

Mark 16:1-8

And when the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of James and Salome bought spices, so that they might go and anoint him. And very early on the first day of the week, when the sun had risen, they went to the tomb. And they were saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?" And looking up, they saw that the stone had been rolled back--it was very large. And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed. And he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen; he is not here. See the place where they laid him.⁷ But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going before you to Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you." And they went out and fled from the tomb, for trembling and astonishment had seized them, and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.
